


HE WHARE AKO, HE WHARE HANGARAU

A HOUSE OF LEARNING, A HOUSE OF TECHNOLOGIES



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A framework underpinned with concepts of ako (teaching + learning) and **Kaupapa Māori**/Māori philosophical values (**KM**), interwoven with **mobile learning (mL)** theories and approaches, conceptualised into a metaphorical visual of a wharenui (traditional meeting house). The framework is a values-based approach to understanding the role of mobile devices and learning in the context of Aotearoa New Zealand. It engages with a range of culturally responsive pedagogies open to the possibilities (i.e. 'affordances') of digital technologies. This framework has been developed for use by the National Project Fund (2014) Learners and Mobile Devices Ako Aotearoa project (coined as the #NPF14LMD project). This poster introduces He Whare Ako, He Whare Hangarau framework ('The Framework') using Augmented Reality (AR) (*see instructions in the footer*).
